HAZELNUT MARKETING BOARD

The Budget Meeting of the Hazelnut Marketing Board will be held May 17th at 8 am at the North Willamette Research and Extension Center in Aurora. The Board will be discussing funding for the annual objective yield survey, promotion projects and research projects currently under way.

MORE ABOUT THE OBJECTIVE YIELD SURVEY

An important activity of the Hazelnut Marketing Board is the determination of a crop size number that is used early in the season for marketing and planning purposes. Many of you have had people from the Oregon Agricultural Statistical Service (OASS) visit your orchards to gather information used to ascertain the best number possible. For the last couple of years the OASS has collaborated with Michael McDaniel; using his imagery to help determine the number of acres actually in production. With the number of acres being planted and the number of acres being pulled out it is very difficult to make a crop projection. The Board is doing everything possible to address the issues that have occurred with new varieties and new plantings.

If the OASS folks call and plan to come to your orchard, please be helpful so that the resulting crop size number is as accurate as possible. If you have issues, let us know by calling 503.678.6823 so we can help alleviate problems. The accuracy really does depend on the ability of the people in the field to get the information they need for the statistical evaluations.

OREGON HAZELNUT COMMISSION

The Budget Meeting of the Oregon Hazelnut Commission will be held June 7th at 8 am at the North Willamette Research and Extension Center. The 2017-18 budget includes funds for the Hazelnut Breeding Program, Advanced Selection Trials, Micropropagation, Disease Management, Filbertworm Biology and Behavior, Precision Irrigation, Foliar Nutrient Analysis, Remote Sensing Water Stress, Flatheaded Borer Management, Optimizing Sucker Control and Shelf Life Studies for a total of \$556,972.
